

A fun spelling game for 2 to 6 players



Setup

- Print out all three daloodoo pages.
- Cut out the cards, be careful with scissors!
- Color the cards to customize your game.



How to play

To begin, shuffle the cards and deal one per player face up.

Place the remaining cards on the draw pile face down.

If you begin with a minus card, place it in the discard pile and you must start with no cards.

If you begin with a swap card, take the starting card from any player then discard the swap.

Take turns to play in a clockwise direction starting with the youngest player.

When it's your turn, take a single card from the draw pile and add it to your set face up so everyone can see.

Double letter cards must be used in the order on the card.

If you draw a wild card, it can be used as any single letter, no doubles!

If you draw a minus, you must choose a card from your set to discard (if you have one), also discard the minus.

If you draw a swap, you must swap one card with another player (even if you don't want to), then discard the swap.

If you use all cards in the draw pile, flip the discard pile face down and place it on the draw pile to continue.

The first person to spell 'daloodoo' or 'win' without mistakes wins the game!
